

STUDENT TEACHING APPLICATION QUINCY/SPRINGFIELD

Application Instructions

Applications are accepted in the Fall the first day of classes and are due no later than September 15th or the preceding business day.

Applications are accepted in the Spring the first day of classes and are due no later than February 15th or the preceding business day.

This is a checklist for you to use when completing your application to Student Teach. INCOMPLETE applications will not be accepted.

For acceptance to Student Teach you will need to meet the following criteria and include the following information with your application:

- 1. Admission to the Teacher Education Program Undergraduate or PDP candidate only (This is N/A for MSE candidates.)
- 2. Passing scores on ISBE Content Tests and on all 4 sections of the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) or the ACT with Writing. ACT in lieu of TAP requires a composite score of 22 or better with a combined English/writing score of 19 or better.
- 3. All required certification courses, content area, and methods courses must be completed with a GRADE OF "C" or higher. New ISBE requirement for graduation: you must have Reading in the Content Area (EDU345 for undergraduate or PDP students or MSE544 for graduate students) on your transcript or show proof that you are currently enrolled in the course to apply to Student Teach.
- 4. Background Check FBI and Illinois Background Checks must be completed as part of your application to Student Teaching, however, they cannot be done until your student teaching placement has been made. You will be conditionally accepted into Student Teaching until all required documents and tests are completed, including Background Checks. Please see Moodle Course "School of Education Student Resources" for more information, or visit the School of Education office.
- 5. Cumulative GPA of 2.6 or higher
- 6. Declared major correctly stated on your transcript. Change of major or minor is done through the Registrar's Office.
- 7. No additional academic or dispositional concerns
- 8. Include 2 recommendations from instructors in the School of Ed. If you are a secondary education major, include 1 recommendation from a School of Ed. instructor and 1 from an instructor in your content area. If you are a transfer student, these may come from education instructors at your previous institution. If a content area instructor is not available, get a reference from a Math/Science Methods instructor or a practicum instructor.
- Please note application for TEP and Student Teaching should <u>NOT</u> be done at the same time. Per ISBE guidelines, you must be fully admitted into TEP at least one full semester before student teaching.
- 10. Attach a copy of your transcript showing all of your coursework; this may be printed from your MOODLE account.
- 11. Program completion needs to be verified. Undergraduate/PDP students should provide a degree audit from the Registrar's Office and MSE students should get a signed checklist from his/her advisor.
- 12. Submit a 1-2 page essay addressing the following:
 - o How you have incorporated the key components of the School of Education's mission statement into your teaching.
 - o How your views on classroom management, discipline, and your own teaching practices have changed to reflect these elements.

<u>ALL</u> of the above information and materials must be submitted <u>together</u> to the School of Education. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
