If a course or requirement is waived, e.g. a transfer course for fewer hours than stated on the degree plan is accepted for credit for a required course, the difference in credit hours must be taken as nursing or non-nursing electives, so the total hours required remain 124. Students must take ENG 111 and ENG 112, plus 2 other Writing Enriched (W:) courses, one that must be in their major.
