- Complete ≥ 30 hrs in residency with ≥ 21 hrs in major
- Complete ≥ 56 hrs at a 4-year institution

#### QUALITATIVE

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 overall
- A minimum GPA of 2.0 in major and relevant minor coursework
