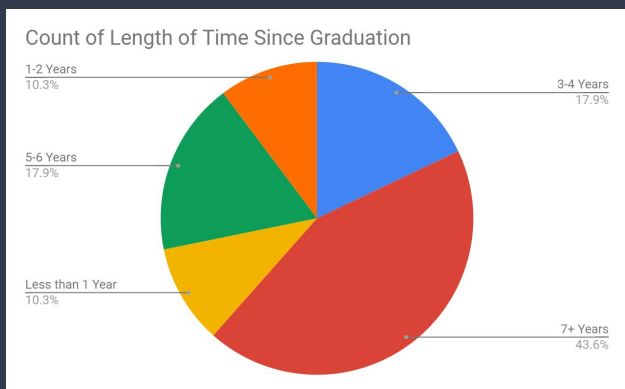

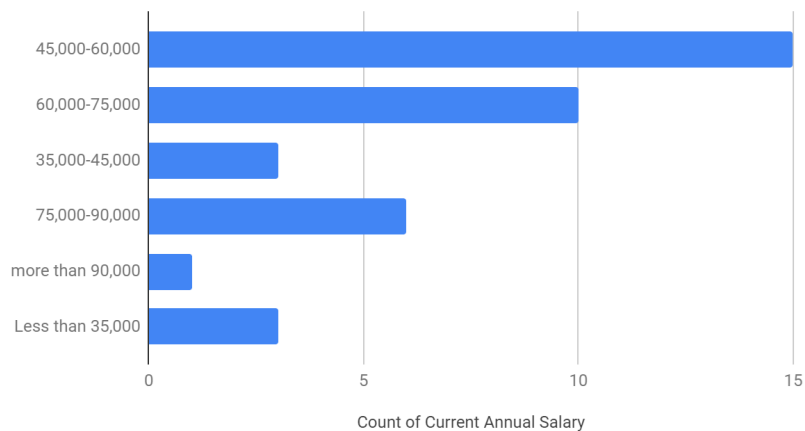
Practicum Placement Rate:

100% of practicum students were placed during the 2023-2024 academic year.

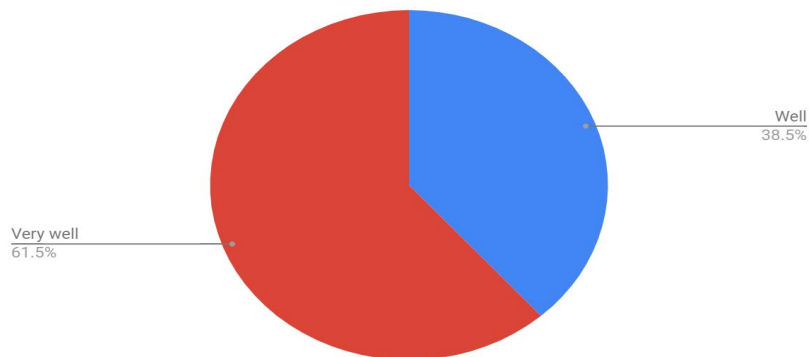
Alumni Survey Findings



2023-2024 Current Annual Salary

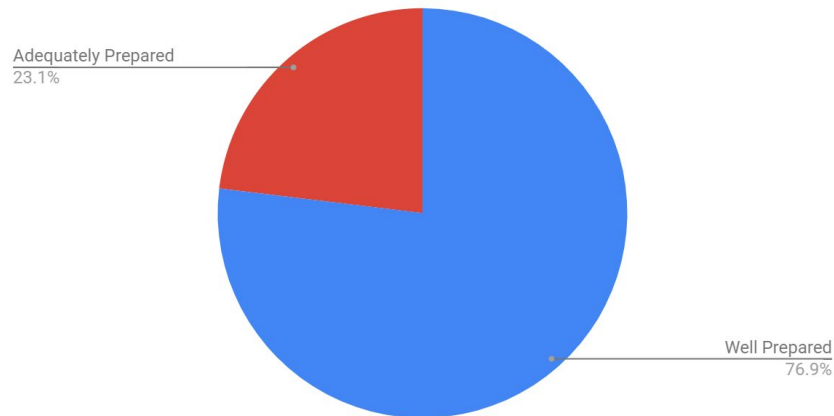


Count of How well did the MEC program prepare you for work as a counseling professional?

Focus on theoretical orientation, plenty of opportunity to master the basic skills of counseling, professional development

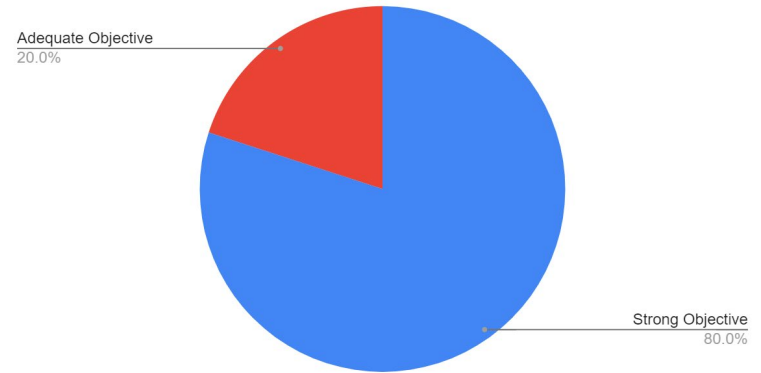
