What Do You Know about the Bonaventure Program?

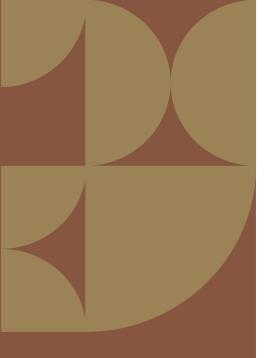
If you are a senior just about ready to graduate, chances are you have heard about the Bonaventure Program. If you are not a senior, you may not have heard about the Bonaventure Program so *here is what you need to know.*

The Bonaventure Program is built upon the pursuit of knowledge and a desire to know Christ as demonstrated in the work of Saint Bonaventure, a 13th century Franciscan scholar. The Bonaventure Program represents a list of 14 learning outcomes (skills) that we hope students develop during their time at Quincy University. Regardless of your major, you will take classes that will provide opportunities for you to engage in these 14 learning outcomes which include skills such as written communication, oral communication, problem-solving, and critical thinking. So, why is the Bonaventure Program important to you? Because you will need to create an eportfolio comprised of significant assignments that demonstrate engagement in the Bonaventure Program. The eportfolio is referred to as the Bonaventure Program eportfolio. in your senior year at QU, you must take the BPP 410 class in order to construct your Bonaventure program eportfolio.

So, what should you be doing now to prepare for the Bonaventure Program ePortfolio? Be sure to save all of your assignments, preferably on Google drive so that you will have easy access to them during your senior year. Do You Have a LiveText Account?

Have any of your instructors asked you to upload an assignment to LiveText? At some point during your time at QU, you will be asked to submit a class assignment to LiveText. LiveText is an online management system, much like Moodle, used for the Bonaventure Program. Remember, prior to graduation, you will be required to submit an eportfolio that showcases your engagement with the Bonaventure Program. LiveText is a place where you can upload and store class assignments that you will eventually use in your Bonaventure Program ePortfolio.

Do You Have a LiveText Account? To upload assignments to LiveText, you will need to have a LiveText account. This is different than your Moodle account or QU login credentials. The account is free to you but will expire if you do not register it. Please contact Dr. Barb Rowland (at rowlaba@quincy.edu), LiveText Coordinator, to activate your account.



Are You Registered for BPP 110, 310, or 410?

Are you enrolled in BPP 110 or 310? All freshmen are automatically enrolled in BPP 110, and all transfer students are automatically enrolled in BPP 310. These courses will show up on your schedule and in Moodle; however, they ARE NOT classes you need to attend. Instead, they are course shells that you can click on in Moodle to obtain more information about the Bonaventure Program, the ePortfolio graduation requirement, and LiveText. You have been enrolled in BPP 110 or 310 as a way for the university to assist you with your LiveText needs and to make you aware of the Bonaventure Program eportfolio requirement.

Are you enrolled in BPP 410? If you are graduating in May 2023, you should have either taken BPP 410 in Fall 2022 or be enrolled for Spring 2023. BPP 410 IS A CLASS YOU MUST ATTEND. This is a 7-week online course that helps you construct and submit the Bonaventure program ePortfolio. You will need to register for BPP 410 the semester prior to graduation. It is a graduation requirement.
