Students must complete two of the three required practica (two Criminal Justice and one Psychology) and must substituted a 300-400 level Criminal Justice or Psychology elective in the area of the practicum not taken.

#### TRANSFER STUDENTS WITH A.A. OR A.S. DEGREE All Bonaventure Program courses are fulfilled with the exception of any two 3 SH TRS, a 300 level Ethics (E:) course, a Diversity (D:) course, a Global (G:) course, two writing-enriched (W:) courses, and any other major requirements.

### SERVICE LEARNING REQUIREMENTS
