Flowchart for Academic Dishonesty Cases

- 1. Incident of academic dishonesty
- 2. Professor is allowed to check the alleged offender's record in the Academic Dishonesty database (except for pending cases as described below in 4bii).
- 3. Professor completes the Disposition for Alleged Academic Dishonesty form
- 4. Professor meets with student
 - a. Alternative 1:
 - i. Student signs 2nd line of the Disposition, accepting that he/she is accused of violating academic standards and accepting the penalty given by the professor at the course level
 - ii. Record of case is sent to the database
 - b. Alternative 2:
 - i. Student disputes case, either signing the 1st line of the Disposition or refusing to sign. In the latter case, the professor will note "student refused to sign" on the 1st signature line of the Disposition.
 - ii. Record of case is sent to the database, triggering the normal appeals process of the university. During the appeal, the case is considered to be pending.
 - iii. If student is judged not guilty, record of case is expunged from the database
- 5. Repeat offenses will automatically trigger a review process on the university level, which will decide on the appropriate additional penalties given.
