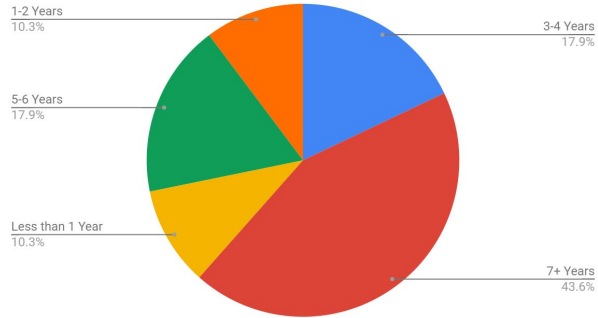

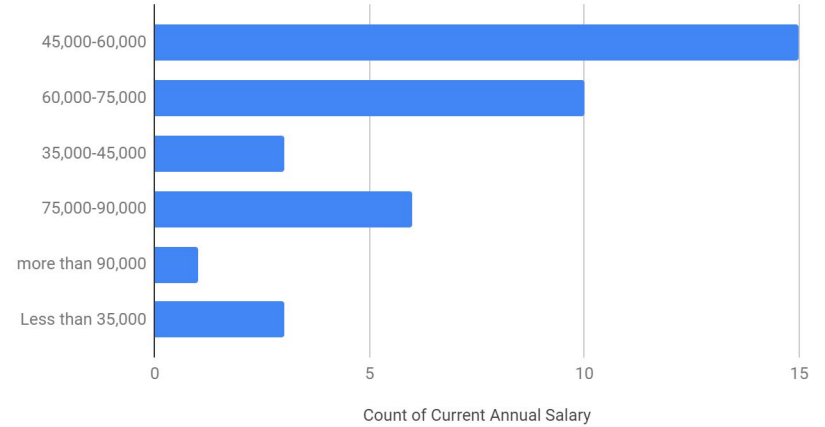

# Alumni Survey Findings

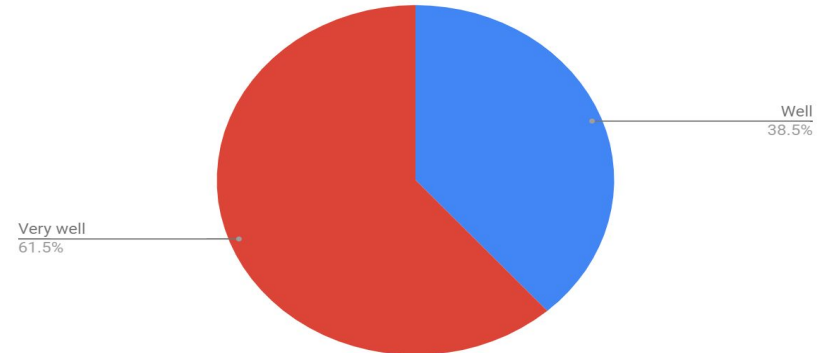
Count of Length of Time Since Graduation



2023-2024 Current Annual Salary

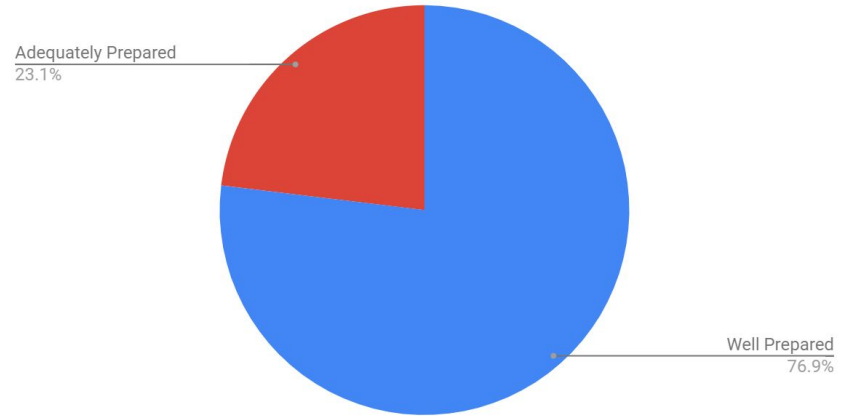


Count of How well did the MEC program prepare you for work as a counseling professional?

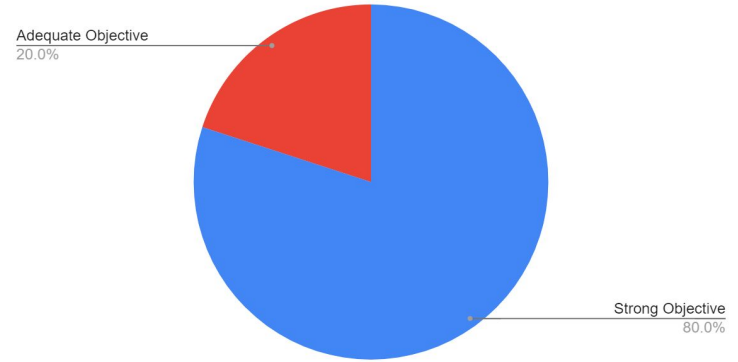

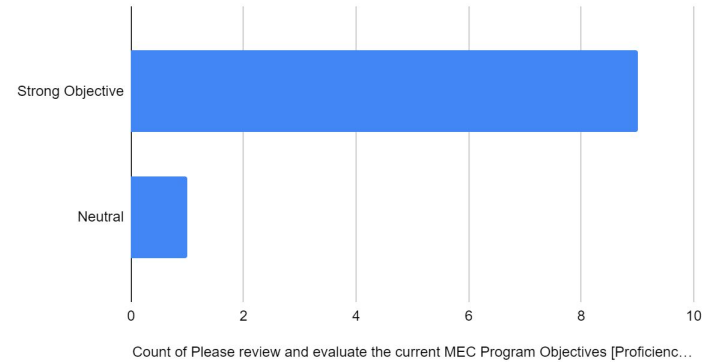
